

April 2, 2014

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes and Passineau were absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the March 19, 2014 meeting minutes. Rickaby seconded it. Motion passed.

The board reviewed Ordinance 4-2-14; Ordinance Requiring Payment of Local Claims as Condition of Obtaining or Renewing Town issued Licenses or Permits. In order for a license or permit to be issued all fees due to the Town have to be paid. Frank made a motion to adopt Ordinance 4-2-14. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

North American Services Group, 6511 State Hwy 13 South, requested a new business permit. It is for industrial cleaning. Any special OSHA standards would need to be followed. Heeg made a motion to grant the permit. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to grant the operator's license for William Nieman. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board discussed the transfer site for 2014. Everything will be the same as 2013.

Metal and Tires

The transfer site on County Road Z South will be open the Second and last Saturday of the month, April thru October, from 9:00 A.M. until 4:00 P.M. for the collection of metal and tires.

Identification will be checked.

The transfer site will accept up to 10 passenger or light truck tires 17 inches or less per address, per year, with no fee.

Residents owning more than one property in the Town will only be allowed 10 tires total free of charge, any over the 10 will be charged.

Business addresses will not be allowed to bring in the 10 tires free of charge.

All other tires:

\$3 per tire for passenger and light truck tires 17 inches or less, over the 10 per address limit.

\$3 per tire for any racing slicks, ATV, Garden Tractor and motorcycle tires

\$10 per tire for tires that are from 17 inches to tractor trailer tires

\$15 per tire for farm tractor tires

All tires taken are at the discretion of the Town employees at the transfer site.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Dave would like to put a list of lost and found dogs on the Town's website. It would save the residents money and time if they didn't have to pick their dogs up from the Humane Society.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. Billie-Jo will contact the schools to see if they had any questions about the logo contest and see if a \$25 gift certificate could be given to the winner. June 21, 2014 from 9AM to 1PM will be Choose to Reuse. Dog licenses were due March 31, 2014. \$15 late fees will now be assessed.

Nathan Ward is working with US Cellular to find a site for a cell tower. They are looking at the transfer site area. Rickaby will meet with Nathan to look at the site and get plans started.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
