

August 2, 2017

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed August 1st, 2017.

Passineau made a motion to approve the minutes for July 19th, 2017 regular meeting Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the EMS Report. The Wisconsin Rapids Fire Department has been great to work and train with. The Town has received the stipend from the City for \$520 for emergency calls where a Saratoga EMS person was on the scene. The money will go into the general fund.

Forbes made a motion to table the discussion regarding the ATV/UTV access to AA Roadhouse until property owners have been contacted. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Heeg made a motion to approve the operator's licenses for Jerome Jacobs and David Kester. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

The Board discussed garbage pick-up throughout the Town. There are furniture items that are being left on the side of the road and not being picked up. The Board would like the driver to either tag the items to let the property owner know that they need to call in to the Advanced Disposal to have the item picked up, or have the driver make a note of the address and have the item picked up by the special truck from the company. The Clerk will call to address this issue. There have been properties with no dwelling that have been leaving garbage out for pick-up days. Those properties do not get charged a garbage fee on their taxes. The Board will continue to watch the properties and take pictures. If the garbage is continually being left out, the garbage charge will be put on the property taxes.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable report.

Ken Jaecks told Mr. Brehm during the clean-up of his properties that he may have other cars on the property because he is detailing them. Ken does not have a business permit for this.

He will need to pay his fines and charges owed to the Town before the permit will be granted.

Mike Zurfluh requested to have a mobile home parked on the Evergreen Avenue for a week if he put barricades around it. Dave told him that it is illegal and dangerous, and the Town would not allow him to park in along the side of the road. The Clerk will call Mike and let him know that he would have to obtain a moving permit for the mobile home.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer report.

Correspondences were read.

Passineau said that Ten Mile and Star Lane have gravel placed on them. They will be pulverized and asphalted. New culverts were placed at the entrances of both Star Lane and Wagonwheel. Dips that were repaired will have asphalt placed on them when they have had adequate time to settle.

The County received a grant to help pay for the lowering the culvert on Silver Canoe Drive.

Heeg made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Town books were audited.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed

unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
