

August 5, 2015

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Frank was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the July 15th and 22nd, 2015 meeting minutes. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

David Kester, from the Saratoga ATV Club, would like the Board to approve adding the rest of Ranger Road as a route to the ATV/UTV Ordinance. Boone's Saloon has stated that they would give the club money if the road was opened. The money received would be given to the Town to reimburse for previous signs that have purchased and installed on other routes within the Town. Passineau stated that any signs installed need to be installed with a 4x4 post and set to standard heights. People need to know that the Town only has routes and no trails within the Town. Chairman Rickaby made a motion to approve the rest of Ranger Road. The Saratoga ATV Club will install and maintain the signs. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

The Protect Wood County would like to use the Town hall for meeting the 2nd and 4th Monday's of each month. The Board approved the use without a fee.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the building inspector's report. Joseph Mowery has installed 2 signs along Ten Mile Avenue. At least one has been installed after the sign ordinance was adopted. Lorelei has been in contact with the owner and let him know that the sign would need to be removed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the operator's license for Mary Knuteson. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Advertising for asphalt and gravel bids for Evergreen Avenue will be placed in the paper. Bids will be opened and acted on September 2, 2105.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Turner at 605 Hwy 73 gave the Board a clean-up plan. He would like 60 more days. The Board approved. Tim Hughes was approved to have a trailer on his property while he builds his house until August 1, 2015. Dave will check to see if the trailer is still on the property. Dave and Chairman Rickaby will meet with the Towns' attorney regarding Dean Folts. The Board will continue to work with the Towns' attorney on the changes to the nuisance ordinance.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report. Carol and Louis Layton would like to use the Town hall for their 50th wedding anniversary. The board would like them to use the hall for free. They will need to pay the security deposit, but will get it returned to them when the event is over.

Town books were audited.

Correspondence was read.

Heeg made a motion to approve the bills paid. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
