

August 6, 2014

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the July 16th closed and the July 16th and July 23rd meeting minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to approve a socio-economic concerns and impacts letter be sent to the DNR on behalf of the Town of Saratoga. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adopt the Wood County All Hazards Mitigation Plan. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to introduce a resolution to discontinue and vacate a section of Mill Avenue. The section of road used to be Town right-of-way before the Hwy 73 intersection was changed. The Resolution will be voted on at the September 17, 2014 meeting. The party that was interested in the property will be responsible for legal fees incurred in researching and creating the resolution and the publication fees.

The Utility fees and permit were discussed and reviewed and will be discussed at the next meeting.

Transfer site hours were discussed. The Transfer site hours through the end of October will be from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The municipal court fees have increased by \$10. A new list of fees will be requested by the Municipal court to have on file.

The roadman qualification for the open position as of January 1, 2015 will be discussed at the next meeting.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Tim Hughes, 654 Ranger Road requested to have a semi-trailer on his property approximately a year. He is using it to put building materials in while he remodels his house. Passineau made a motion to approve the trailer until August 1, 2015. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

13 tickets were sent out to dog owners who have not paid for their licenses for the year.

A clean-up letter was sent to Chase Robinson at 8531 County Trunk Z.

4310 Evergreen Avenue is due for an inspection the weekend of August 9th.

A meeting with Leo Piatz and his lawyer is scheduled for Thursday, August 14th. They currently have many trucks and other things on their property that is not their dealer's license address.

The property just to the south of Ken White on Hwy 13 has not cleaned a thing. A ticket will be sent.

10631 Rangeline Road has been cleaned. Jeff Anderson on Rangeline Road has also cleaned his property.

John Sweet is requesting more time for the clean-up. Dave will do an inspection next week at his property.

K&S are putting brush behind Spranger's. It was okayed by the Chairman. They are going to chip the brush.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report.

Power Play has things within the Town's right-of-way along Hollywood Road. The items need to be removed so they are not a hazard to drivers.

There are several posts that are rotted along Kraft Court. The Roadman will replace them.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. 10022 County Road Z was tax deeded back to Wood County.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.
