

December 17, 2014

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the December 3rd meeting minutes. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Sam Heeg gave the EMS report. They will be having a Ride 4 Life motorcycle ride and a St. Patrick's Day party for fundraisers in 2015.

After speaking to the Towns' attorney the Blasting Ordinance will be incorporated in the Zoning Ordinance. The Blasting Ordinance was tabled until a later date.

A zoning letter was requested by a bank. Since it is the first request, the Zoning Administrator created a letter. Passineau made a motion to set the fee for the letter at \$60 and the Zoning Administrator will receive 80% of the fee. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to set the part-time roadmen wage to the current lowest roadman wage. Heeg seconded it. Passineau abstained. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to allow Wayne Coon to carry over above 40 hours of vacation in 2015 because of special circumstances. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Billie Jo gave the Treasurer's report.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. John Sweet property has not been cleaned up at all. A ticket will be issued to him. There is a property on 59th Street that Dave will send a spring clean-up letter. Leo Piatz has begun removing items from his 10720 Hwy 13 south location. Dave Ramsden pled not guilty for having a storage container at the furniture store on Hwy 13. The container has been at the location significantly longer than the Town allows, according to an agreement between Dave Ramsden and the Town.

The Town will need to get an agreement with the Village of Port Edwards for plowing the road from Hwy 13 to the YMCA camp. The municipalities currently have an agreement for plowing Townline Road.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
