

February 19, 2014

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the February 5, 2014 meeting minutes. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

One quote for Town insurance was received. The Board reviewed an insurance quote from Nathan Pezewski from the Horton Group. The best policy with the lowest rate was with Western World thru the Horton Group. Passineau made a motion to accept the policy, including Workers Compensation, with a premium of \$25,668.06. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The new business permit for Scrubby's was not submitted at the time of the meeting so no action was taken.

Frank made a motion to grant operator's licenses for Susan Olson. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Lorelei discussed raising the fee for moving a mobile home within a park to \$75. She has to inspect services and the setting of the home. Passineau made a motion to adopt the amended fee schedule that increases the fee of a Manufactured Home Install from \$50 to \$75. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Doug Andres gave the EMS report. There are currently at 15 members

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Trial for Ken White will be held February 26, 2014 for all the tires he has sitting at his property on Hwy 13.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building inspector's report. She has issued 6 permits in 2014. She has received a few calls about the sign letter that was sent out to businesses. She will call them to answer questions.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. Tax season is finished and went well.

Passineau discussed that the salt is running low and is at \$130 a ton, which is a high price. So they are using the salt sparingly. Sand is being used on the roads, but people still need to slow down since there are scattered slippery spots on the roads.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
