

February 4, 2015

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the January 21st, 2015 meeting minutes. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Peter Manley with the UW Extension would like to have a Clean Sweep. They have money from the County and a grant from the State for the event. Passineau made a motion to allow Clean Sweep at the Town Hall for October 3, 2015 from 8:00-12:00. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Leo Piatz, 6540 Hwy 13, would like to build a 40x60 pole building. He would take down 2 smaller garages. He is going to store collector vehicles. He is not building the building according to commercial code, so he may not use the building for commercial use. He has sold his property at 10720 Hwy 13 south. Frank made a motion to approve the building permit for a 40x60 building as long as there is enough room on the property. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to grant a one-day beverage license for the Saratoga EMS. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board reviewed the fire bill for Alexander Kline. The Board stated that he must pay \$326.25 for the fire call.

The Board reviewed an agreement for road maintenance and work on South Shore Drive. The Board will invite the Village Board to discuss the agreement.

Frank made a motion to grant the operator's license for Danielle McDonald. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board discussed purchasing a new road ditch mower. Passineau will check on pricing.

Frank Cammarata, 1st Call Explosive Solutions, discussed the items he has stored at 9051 Hwy 13 South. He uses the items to do industrial cleaning of boilers. He has had the containers at the property for 15 years. He is regulated by the ATF and notifies the Sheriff and fire departments.

Nathan Pezewski from the Horton Group, reviewed a proposed quote for 2015 insurance. He is still checking on the public official's liability and will have a final quote for the Board at the next meeting.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the building inspector's report. Any mobile homes brought into the Town have to be HUD approved.

Billie Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. Saratoga Cranberry would like to have the garbage taken off the business properties taxes. Mike Osborne would like the garbage taken off the property with the storage units and the property with the house. The Board approved the removal of the garbage fee for Saratoga Cranberry and Mike Osborne's storage units. The garbage fee will stay on the house.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Correspondence was read.

Heeg made a motion to approve the bills paid. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:18 p.m.
