The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the June 17th, 2015 meeting minutes. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to approve Operator Licences for David Kester, Dan McCarville, and Andrea Linzmeier. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

The Saratoga ATV Club would like to have more roads added as routes to the ATV/UTV Ordinance. The Club still owes the Town \$1477 for the signs that were ordered and installed on the current routes. The Board tabled the discussion until they hear back from the Club about the payment of the bills.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the building inspector's report.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. The Humane Society sends Dave paperwork when a dog is released to anyone within the Town of Saratoga. He is able to see if the dog has a license. Ron Ebert on Pine Haven Court, and 582 Ranger Road will be sent tickets if the junk on their property has not been cleaned. Saratoga Auto does not have a valid dealer's license. A clean-up letter was sent and nothing has been moved. A ticket will be sent. Earl Erdman has his property almost all cleaned. Richard DuBois was issued a ticket for moving a mobile home out of a park without a proper permit. Dave would like the Board to look into the process for ticketing. Sometimes there are people that get extensions, still not get the property cleaned up, and then just pay the ticket, which isn't a large amount of money. He would like the 2nd and 3rd tickets to be significantly more so that there more leverage to get the property cleaned. A meeting will be scheduled with the Towns' attorney to discuss the Towns options.

The Board discussed the corner of Hwy 13 and Townline Road. It is a very dangerous corner to pull off of because of the signs and car sitting at the business. Passineau will speak to the DOT. There is a small vision triangle at that corner.

Passineau will check into the paint on Townline Road. It is peeling off the road.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report.

Correspondence was read.

County Board Supervisor, Bill Liechtnam, was told by the CEED Committee Chair, that they would not pay for him to go to a Conservationist Meeting held at Hotel Mead. The meeting will have great information for not only the County, but also the Town. Forbes said the fee for the meeting should be taken out of his donation fund.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
