The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Passineau was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 meeting minutes. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Mark Pechinski gave the EMS report. He spoke about their training. Their upcoming Ride 4 Life fundraiser, which will be held on August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2015, will be a ride to Iowa and back.

Phillip Mlsna, 5821 Pine Ridge Trail, was concerned about the speed limit on the road. The speed limit now is 55 mph. The Town is only allowed to lower the speed by 10 mph. A study by the State would have to be done to get the speed any lower. The resident requested the Board to not worry about the speed if they can't get it any lower.

Brian Hamm and Rob Borski have been doing monitoring of the 7 mile and 10 mile creeks for about 2 years. They are testing water flow speed, water levels, and chemical levels. They were awarded a grant from the DNR last year for the testing that they are doing. All their information collected is also shared with the DNR.

Forbes made a motion to approve the Certified Survey Map for Kevin Powell. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the building inspector's report. More portable signs are showing up in the Town. She will check on those signs.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. He is waiting to send out any more tickets until the procedure and forfeiture amounts are discussed with the Towns' attorney.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report. Town books will be Audited at the August 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Bruce Dimick stated that a few representatives from the Protect Wood County group will be on The Glen Moberg show on FM 89.11 on July 30<sup>th</sup> from 10-11AM. Representatives from the Golden Sands Company have also been invited.
