Dave will ask for the registrations of the vehicles sitting at the property. John Sweet was supposed to have his property cleaned up by the end of November according to his clean-up plan. There has been no progress on his property. The board will review it at the next meeting.

Pavloski's have started paving South Shore subdivision. The board will look into what will need to be done to get the speed limit lowered on the road.

Monitoring wells will be put in in the next few weeks. All the wells will be put in on Town right-of-ways.

The Plan Commission is almost done with the Frac Sand Ordinance.
