

September 21, 2016

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the minutes for September 7, 2016. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Don Harnisch, Nekoosa Ambulance Chief, gave the Board more information about the contract to begin 2017. He stated there might be an increase after 2018, but not an annual increase of 5%. He would also like one member from each municipality come to 2 meetings each year.

The conveyance for East Shore subdivision states that garbage trucks may use the private roads in the subdivision. The Board approved to allow garbage pick-up through the Town.

Frank made a motion to approve the operator's license for Lily Kurszewski. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Dawn and Manuel Jr Harn requested a business permit for Rapids Home Furnishing located at 7830 Hwy 13 South. They have been working with the building inspector to make sure all violations are being corrected. Forbes made a motion to grant the permit contingent the Fire Department inspects and approves the business. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the Certified Survey map for Alan Wondzell. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report.

Forbes made a motion to have the Towns' attorney go forward with the acquisition of .48 acres of donated land. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Catherine Piatz contacted the Constable about the property at 799 Hwy 73 South. She stated that it is just a garage sale and they only plan to do it for a few more weeks. It would be considered a re-sale shop and the Board stated that they would need to get a business permit and be inspected by the fire department. Chairman Rickaby will contact Dennis Trickle and John Sweet regarding inspection of their properties.

Correspondence was read.

Tony Berger would like the Board to discuss the beer license for his property at 6421 Hwy 13 south. The Board made the decision at the last meeting to not to allow the Class B Beer license from the building at 830 Townline transfer to 6421 Hwy 13 South. The Chairman denied the request to be placed on the next agenda.

Allen Wondzell purchased the property at 9420 Hwy 13 South. He would like the garbage and recycling charge to be removed, since there is no dwelling on the property the fee will be removed from the taxes.

Forbes attended an airport commission meeting. Although the Town would be unable to support the commission monetarily, we could possible support them with a resolution of support.

The Town will contact United to get information about Ambulance coverage.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
