

December 16, 2020

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 pm in the town hall. Acting Chairman Passineau called the meeting to order. Chairman Rickaby was absent. The meeting was officially noticed on December 10, 2020.

Heeg made a motion to approve the minutes for December 2, 2020 meeting. Carrell seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Carrell made a motion to amend the minutes for November 4, 2020 minutes. McDonald seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

The Certified survey map was reviewed for the Dennis Rogers property on the corner of Church Avenue and 24<sup>th</sup> Street. The septic tanks and vents have been marked for lot 1 and lot 2 on the map as requested. McDonald made a motion to approve the CSM. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Bids were received from Mid-State Truck, Monroe Truck and Truck Country. Heeg made a motion to allow Passineau to review and accept the bid of the truck that would be most advantageous for the Town. Carrell seconded it. After further discussion the Board would like to meet and go over the bids together before deciding which truck bid to accept. The motion was changed. Carrell made a motion to accept the bids for consideration and review and will make a decision at the January 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Rapids Home Furnishings, 7830 Hwy 13 South had a storage containers delivered on December 14<sup>th</sup>. No representative from the company was present to discuss the extension requested.

Ray Gile wanted to discuss the possibility to have a street light placed at the intersection of Hwy 13 South and Natures Way. Currently there are 3 houses on Natures Way. The State will not install streetlights. The Town will need to discuss and set a policy for when and where street lights are placed. The last streetlights that were installed was in 2000.

Carrell made a motion to approve the yearly membership to the Town Advocacy Counsel for \$1313. Heeg seconded it. Motion approved unanimously.

The following licenses were requested through June 30, 2021;

Operator's license for Sabrina Saylor.

McDonald made a motion to grant licenses. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report. There has not been much construction due to the increase in price of building materials.

Brandon Burroughs gave the constables report.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the treasurer's report. Tax collection has started and the office is open for collection.

She has received an email from a town resident wanting to obtain a shipping container, remodel it into a hunting shack on their property in Saratoga, then move it to their property outside of Saratoga once it was completed. The Town does not allow storage containers. It will be forwarded to the Building Inspector to follow-up on.

Heeg made a motion to approve the Certified Survey Map received for Parker Frederick on Blue Ridge Lane. Carrell seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

McDonald made a motion to approve the Certified Survey Map received for North Shore Properties on Forest Trail. It is part of the boundary agreement area with the Town of Port Edwards. It meets Town Specifications. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Dan Forbes, Josh McDonald and Rhonda Carrell are interested in being on the committee for the Trail Sign Program involving local municipalities.

Jay Capek wanted to know if the Town was looking into extending Beppler Road. The Town has not. He questioned the access to landlocked property south of his property. He would need to check with the Register of Deeds or an abstractor to see if there was an easement to the property.

McDonald made a motion to pay bills. Carrell seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Heeg made a motion to adjourn. McDonald seconded it. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 pm.
