The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Nelson made a motion to approve the February 16th minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Roland Hawk from Jewell Associates gave the board the status of the project on Rangeline Road. The Army Corp of Engineers approved the Town to fill the wetlands. In order to be easier for the bussing the project won't start until after school ends. The Board would like to work through Wood County and use bridge aid. Passineau abstained from discussing this due to conflict of interest.

Frank made a motion to approve the one-day beverage license for the American Legion for March 19th. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

The Town will do a title search on the Reagan property at 9598 County Road Z in order to continue with the razing process.

Misty Montalbano was renting a house at 993 State Hwy 73 South. She had contacted the Wood County Health Department about the condition of the house and they told her to contact the Town. She showed the Board pictures of the house and told them about the condition of the house. The Board would like the Building Inspector to inspect the property.

Forbes made a motion to approve a resolution repealing the present prevailing wage law. They would like it returned to the 2009 threshold. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the purchase of an ADA compliant portable speaker system for the board room for \$3070.00. In order to be in compliance with the law, the Town would need to have the system. If we did not have it, the Town could get a large fine. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed. Chairman Rickaby will check into getting extra microphones for the system.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Frank will go to a fireworks meeting with Tom Spranger in order to get more information that would be helpful to the Town in setting up a fireworks ordinance.

Correspondence was read.

Nelson made a motion to approve the bills paid. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
