

June 1, 2011

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to accept the minutes for May 18, 2011. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

An ad requesting bids for gravel will need to be run in the paper another time. It will be on the agenda for July 6<sup>th</sup>.

The board discussed outdoor music with Ray Lowell and Michael Osborne. The Board did receive numerous complaints about the noise last summer. The Town doesn't want to put an ordinance in place to make it tougher for the bars to stay open. They would like to work along with the bars to try and keep all residents satisfied. The City of Wisconsin Rapids has an ordinance in place that says that the music has to be kept at 70 decibels or under at the lot line. The board agreed that getting a decibel reader to find out how loud the music is, and try to keep it under the 70 decibels. Also the board also requested that the bars turn the music down later at night.

If they don't get their dogs' licensed, they will receive a citation.

Ditching is being done on the County line. If there is enough money in the budget ditching will be done on Bell Road by the bridge that is going to be replaced next year. A chipper is going to be brought into the old landfill to get rid of all the brush that residents have brought in after the tornado.

The board will not put an ordinance or resolution in place regarding fireworks. If anyone is shooting fireworks, it is against the State Statute.

Forbes will check with Jewell Associates for Planned Unit Developments regarding Roy Ferkey's retirement community.

There were many emergency departments and volunteers that helped in the Town after the tornado struck on May 22. The Town Board is grateful for all the help the Town received. A note will be put in the paper thanking everyone.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Frank made a motion to pay the bills. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Correspondence was read.
