The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the December 5, 2012 meeting minutes with corrections. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Pat Pavloski wondered if the Town was going to snow plow South Shore Drive. The Town is not getting aid from the road since it has not been accepted by the Town yet. The road has to be completed before the Town will accept it. The Pavloski's will continue snowplowing the road until it is accepted by the Town.

Passineau made a motion to adopt Ordinance 12-19-12A; Ordinance Repealing Interim Zoning Ordinance. Provided that the Town Zoning Ordinance remains in full force and effect, the Interim Zoning Ordinance will be repealed. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to adopt Ordinance 12-19-12B; Ordinance Repealing Moratorium Ordinance. Provided that the Town Zoning Ordinance remains in full force and effect, the Moratorium Ordinance will be repealed. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Information was given to board members and residents present pertaining to application of liquid animal manures using center pivot irrigation systems. Passineau made a motion to adopt Ordinance 12-19-12C; Ordinance Prohibiting Application of Liquid Animal Manures Using Center Pivot Irrigation Systems. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The use of Center Pivot Manure Distribution Systems is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and the use of Center Pivot Manure Distribution Systems is strictly prohibited within the Town of Saratoga.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Installations of extra driveways along Young Street were discussed. Bills will be sent to property owners that requested extra driveways.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
