The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the Special meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed. 7 residents attended the meeting.

At the April 16, 2013 Annual meeting the electors approved the Town Supervisors to spend up to \$1,083,000 for the joint municipality road reconstruction of Townline Road. After all bids were received for the project the Town board realized that the project was going to exceed the engineer's estimate. The total portion that the Town would need to pay will be no more than \$1,250,000. The 2013 budget should cover \$380,000, and the reimbursement from the State after the project is completed is \$438,500. It will leave a total of \$431,500 that will need to be paid back from the 2014 and 2015 road construction budgets. Nancy Nichols accepted Resolution 8-26-13; A Resolution Authorizing the Town Supervisors to Exceed Highway Expenditure Limits up to \$1,250,000. Patty Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. 7 approved. No opposed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
