The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the December 2, 2015 meeting minutes. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the EMS report. They are selling tickets for raffle prizes for their fundraiser in March.

Lamar has a sign within the right of way on Nature's Way. They will have to remove from the right of way.

Passineau approve the Certified Survey Map for Jay Nabbefeldt. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to allow the Boy Scouts to use the Town hall for February 20, 2016. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to appoint the list of Election workers for 2016-2017. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board and residents in attendance chose a logo for the Town.

The Town will need to pay sales tax on money paid for the hall rental. The sales tax will need to be added to the regular fee.

Passineau made a motion to allow the Tri Lakes Association and the Rome Water Utility to place a water monitoring well within the right of way along Adams Avenue at about 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue. They must keep the well flush with ground level like the existing ones within the Town. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to allow the change of agent for The Store to Melisa Wanta. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to approve the operator's licenses for Michele Christy, Victoria Smith, Steph Longmore, and Natasha Nelson. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

A monitoring well was damaged at the old landfill. The Town will wait to hear from the DNR on whether it has to be replaced or if the other four monitoring wells would be enough for the site.

Forbes made a motion to approve the business permit and the mobile home license transfers of Boardwalk and Park Place mobile home parks for Sean and Kimberly Montgomery. Each park's new name would have to be unique. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Tony Berger, 830 Townline Road has a beverage license that allows selling and drinking at that location. He also has motorcycle repair and sales at the same location. According to the Department of Revenue he is not allowed to have both types of business at the same location. Tony will be notified.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Dave will take pictures of the mobile home that is on Dean Folts's property that he is using as storage. A clean up letter was sent to Tim Hinz.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report. Tim Kent has a house on the same property as his business. He would like to have the garbage pickup taken off the taxes for the property. The Board said that he would have to continue to pay the garbage fee. Every dwelling must have garbage pickup.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
