

May 20, 2015

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the May 6th, 2015 meeting minutes. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the EMS report. August 29th, 2015 will be the Ride 4 Life. It will only be a ride. The group is working with Nekoosa to obtain a rehab/fire trailer.

Lorelei gave the building inspector's report. The number of shed permits are up this year. Lorelei will re-work the electrical permit to include solar panels. During roof installations some people will have the wiring following the trusses down. If there was a fire, a fireman could try to ax into the rood and get electrocuted. The permit will help monitor what houses have solar panels. The permits will be forwarded to the fire departments.

Alliant Energy would like to install service to Ten Mile Avenue within the right-of-way. The Town has had issues in the past with getting service moved in a timely manner when the road has need construction work. The Board would like to keep the service outside of the right-of-way.

Quinn Speich, 12188 Old Trail, requested a business permit for a home based gunsmithing/sales. He will do most of his work by phone or appointment only. No shooting will be done on the property. Frank made a motion to grant the business permit. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

The Plan Commission made a recommendation that the Town Board approve the gas station and Subway Restaurant at 9630 Hwy 13 South. Frank made a motion to approve The Store Gas Station and a Subway Restaurant at 9630 Hwy 13 South location. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. The Town has heard from the Wisconsin DOT regarding Ken Jaecks. His dealer's license has expired. Ken Jaecks and the owner of the property will be sent a letter to clean up the property within 30 days. Dave Ramsden's property on Hwy 73 will continued to be watched.

The Furniture Store on Hwy 13 has signs out and has sent notes saying that they are going out of business. The Town has a Closing Out Ordinance. A letter will be sent to the owner.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report. She continues to work on dogs licenses.

Plum Creek would like to run full loads on Ten Mile Creek for cutting timber. The Board does not want more damage done to that road, so will not allow them to run full loads. Plum Creek does have other ways to take the timber out.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
