

August 17, 2016

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the minutes for August 3rd, 2016. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board reviewed bids received from Country Disposal and Advanced Disposal. Country Disposal started at \$11.75/month for the first year, \$12.00/month for the second year, \$12.25/month for the 3rd and 4th year, and \$12.50/ month for the 5th year. Advanced Disposal's rate was \$11.85/month for the entire 5 year period. Passineau made a motion to have Advanced Disposal do garbage and recycling curbside pickup for a five year period starting January 2017. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to continue the cooperative agreement between the City of Wisconsin Rapids, Town of Grand Rapids, Village of Biron and the Town of Saratoga. The agreement allows Town residents to use the compost site after they purchase a ticket for the year. Currently the rate is \$35 a ticket. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to allow Stafford Rosenbaum to draft a Livestock Operation, Animal Waste Management, and Public Health and Groundwater Protection Ordinances. They will report back to the board once the drafts are complete. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to table the Building Code Ordinance until changes have been made. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to approve Resolution #2016-3. It is a resolution to borrow \$255,777 from Nekoosa Port Edwards State Bank for a period of one year at 2.25% to complete roadwork within the town including Bell Road from Hwy 73 to the County line. Passineau seconded the motion. Heeg abstained from discussion and voting due to a conflict of interest. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Dennis Trickle has until 9/1/2016 to complete his clean-up plan. Changes to the nuisance ordinance will be completed and sent to the Towns' attorney for review. Dan Holewinski on Pine Haven Court will be removing the fence that is within the right-of-way. His court date for August 24th is cancelled.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Town books were audited.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:03 p.m.
