

April 5, 2017

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed March 30th, 2017.

Heeg made a motion to approve the closed and open minutes for March 15th, 2017. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Joe Fogarty requested to discuss the right of way on Possum Trail. Joe was not present at the meeting.

The Board discussed the Class B licenses that are due for revocation. Robb Rose and Argil Jackson sent letters contesting the revocation. Robb Rose did not use his license last year at the campground due to medical issues, but plans to use it this summer. Passineau made a motion to allow Robb Rose keep his license for Deertrail Campground; also to move forward with a hearing for Argil Jackson for Crossroads and the revocation date of May 3rd for Idle A While. Frank seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Jaime White was present from Stocor to request an extension for a container to be located at 1340 Ranger Road. It is a container that will be behind a fence at the Telephone property company for some work they are doing. They requested to have the container at the property between 6-9 months, or until the work is finished. Frank made a motion to allow the container on the property for up to 9 months. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Heeg made a motion to change the DBA name to AA Roadhouse from Kimmer's Cheers & Bites. The company name will not change. Frank seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Frank made a motion to grant an operator's license for Joan Goehring. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Frank made a motion to adopt Ordinance 4-5-17; Ordinance relating to issuance of citations for violations of town ordinances. It replaces the previous ordinance with only a change to the Driveway Ordinance number. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

The board would like to table the discussion of future rentals until the full board is in attendance. It will be discussed at the next meeting.

The board discussed the bidding and publication procedures for work that the Town would need done. The Board would like to bid out crackfilling even though it would be under the \$25,000 bidding requirement in order to get the best price. Passineau will put a bid sheet together to put in the paper.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable report. Dave Ramsden pled not guilty for having a storage container on a property without a permit.

The Board members have noticed quite a few properties through the Town that have a lot of items that would be against the Towns' Nuisance Ordinance. The Board will give people a few weeks to clean things up before they start sending out clean-up warnings and tickets.

The garage behind Import Auto has been having more cars on the property. He has told the Board in the past that he is just fixing his family vehicles. Since it is against the State's Uniform Dwelling Code to have a home based repair garage, the board will have the Building Inspector check the property.

Passineau discussed the SE Wood County Groundwater group. They just had a meeting and Kevin Mazarek from UW-Stevens Point spoke to the group. George Kraft also from the UW-Stevens Point spoke to the Wood County CEED Committee today. He said that more people are realizing that the ground and water are different here than it is in other parts of the

County.

The Bridge on Hwy 73 going into Nekoosa will need to have some work done to it. It is planned to start in 2019.

Road postings will be on for at least another week.

Thor Laisy was granted driveway permits in 2006 and 2007. Any that have not been installed are no longer valid since they expire 3 months after they are issued.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed 4 to 0. The meeting adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
