

July 5, 2017

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed June 30 2017.

Heeg made a motion to approve the minutes for June 21, 2017. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Forbes made a motion to table the discussion on REGI until the next meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Passineau made a motion to approve the transfer of the agent for Schierl Sales Corp, The Store, to Michele Christy for their Class A Beer and Liquor license. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Frank made a motion to approve the operator's licenses for Alexander Farley, Michael Laura, Jakota Kimball, Brenda Maki, April Voit, Nicole Brown, and Jeremy Strangfeld. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

The Board discussed the roadwork to be done this year. Wagonwheel will get a wedge and overlay and Star Lane will get pulverized and an overlay along with a dip flattened. Forbes made a motion to use Wood County and use the 50/50 road aid of \$8000 towards the roadwork. Frank seconded it. Passineau abstained. Motion passed unanimously.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable report. Municipal Court outcomes- Jeremy Sievers-violation of the nuisance ordinance, guilty \$124.

Melody Steen-violation of the nuisance ordinance, no contest \$124.

Cody Kickland-use of semi-trailer for storage-not guilty & violation of the nuisance ordinance, not guilty. Cody had the semi's out before he received the ticket and cleaned up all the items off the property, so both tickets will be dismissed.

A storage container was placed at 6230 Mill Avenue and the town was not notified of the placement. Dave issued a ticket. They have since removed the container. The Town will talk to the attorney about the status of the updated Conditional Use permit with Stocor. The Board may look into revoking the conditional use permit since this is a constant issue.

Ken Jaecks has to have his property on Beppler Road cleaned by Friday or abatement will begin.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer report. 28 5-day tickets were sent out to people that did not re-register their dogs. 12 of them have been taken care of so far.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report. 2 older mobile homes on Ranger Road are going to be removed.

Correspondences were read.

Passineau made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:37 p.m.
