Chairman Rickaby called the Annual Meeting for the Town of Saratoga to order at 7:00 p.m. in the town office. All members were present. 6 residents attended the meeting.

The Clerk read the minutes of the 2014 Annual Meeting. Douglas Passineau motioned to approve the minutes as read. Patricia Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The 2014 Financial Report was presented and explained. John Frank made a motion to accept the financial report as presented. Danny Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Next year's Annual Meeting as set by law will be April 19, 2016.

Douglas Passineau reviewed the road work to be done in 2015. Ranger Road from Aqua Drive to Hollywood will be wedged. Evergreen Avenue from 52nd to County Trunk U will be re-constructed since the Town has received a TRI-D grant for \$29,562.85. 10 of the worst dips in the Town will be wedged and paved also.

Rhonda Carrell will serve a three year term on the Board of Adjustments.

The Protect Wood County group has organized water testing collection dates. They will give out bottles from April 30th thru May 3rd, drop-off date of May 3rd. They will take the samples to the UWSP on May 4th.

Douglas Passineau has spoken to Bob Sawyer and Wood County Planning and Zoning about a bike trail in the Town. The County is going to re-do County Road Z, which will add a foot to each shoulder, although the bridges will still be the same width.

Choose to Re-Use will be held on May 30th.

There was a request for a donation for Protect Wood County. The Board discussed whether they were able to do this. The Towns' lawyer will be contacted for legal advice.

Storage containers were close to the road at the Highway 73 Stacor location. The Conditional Use Permit was reviewed.

October 3, 2015 will be Clean Sweep at the Saratoga Town Hall.

There being no further business to discuss, Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
