The Saratoga Town Board met at 5:00 p.m. in the Town Board Room. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed on February 15, 2022.

McDonald made a motion to go into closed session to discuss matters related to the negotiation for the Zoning Administrator for the Town of Saratoga. This closed session is allowed under Wisconsin Statutes section 19.85(1)(e) for the purpose of deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session. Carrell seconded the motion. Roll call was taken; Carrell-aye, Kretschmer-aye, Leichtnam-aye, McDonald-aye, Rickaby-aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Carrell made a motion to adjourn the closed meeting and go into open session. McDonald seconded it. Roll call was taken; Carrell-aye, Kretschmer-aye, Leichtnam-aye, McDonald-aye, Rickaby-aye. Motion passed unanimously.

McDonald made a motion to enter into a contract with Raymond Bossert with a proactive approach at a cost of \$1500/month plus 80% of zoning application fees. There would need to be written in a contract that a 60 day notice would be required by either party if there was a decision to leave. Leichtman seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Leichtnam made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Carrell seconded it. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
