The Saratoga Town Board met with the Saratoga Plan Commission at 5:00 pm in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed on January 19th, 2022.

The Board discussed Roberts Rules of Order and Open Meeting Laws and where resources are available.

There was a request to have all unapproved minutes be sent out to all members of the Town Board, Plan Commission and SPARKS Committee as soon as they are possible.

The Town pledged \$30,000 towards technical assistance funds to prepare an economic development strategy for the community, with a focus on alternative energy and the related supply chain for a federal grant through North Central Wisconsin Regional Plan Commission. Included in this plan, the NCWRPC will also be working on the review and rewrite of the Comprehensive Plan which will take several meetings over several months.

When the Plan Commission is working on the Comprehensive Plan, the Board would like to be able to review a section at a time instead of waiting for the entire plan.

The Town will need to decide if we want to pursue a sewer line in the Town. The Town of Rome may be looking at putting in their own system in since they have a more immediate need for it.

Leichtnam made a motion to adjourn. Carrell seconded it. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:28 p.m.
