Dan Forbes opened the meeting of the Town of Saratoga Plan Commission at 6:30 PM on March 13, 2019 at the Saratoga Town Hall. The meeting was officially noticed.

Motion by Barth to accept the minutes of January 9, 2019, second by Snyder, motion approved.

Grygo presented a summary of changes to the Short-Term Rental Ordinance as suggested at the January 9, 2019 meeting; discussion followed with changes being accepted. It was agreed the sections regarding property manager permit, and property manager qualifications be deleted.

Motion by Barth to send the Short-Term Rental Draft Ordinance to the Town Board for review, second by Snyder, motion approved.

Fuehrer said there are five homes within the “shared area” (Boundary Agreement Territory, as described in Ordinance 2013-12-18), that were not inspected during or after construction. A discussion followed.

Forbes said he would like to explore the possibility of improving the boat land on CTH Z at the county line, and also the possibility of a small landing with parking on Wakley Road. Wipperfurth suggested creating a canoe and kayak access off Sandy Ct., discussion followed.

Wipperfurth said he read an article that listed Wood County as the 49 best places to live in the U.S. and asked why this information is not in the local paper? He also said he was approached by a person concerned about drones.
