

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTION ORDINANCE

State of Wisconsin
Town of Saratoga
Wood County

WEREAS, the Saratoga Town Board has determined that a hazard to the safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Saratoga exists, which hazard is caused by vehicles begin parked on the town road right-of-way during hours when snow is being plowed; and

WHEREAS, notification of the owners of such vehicles parked on town road right-of-way during hours when roads are being plowed is deemed difficult; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Saratoga, Wood County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 Winter Parking Restrictions

During the period of November 1 through April 15, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any town road right-of-way. Any vehicle found parked upon any town road right-of-way may be towed at the owners expense if the Town Road Leadman and/or Town Board Member shall deem necessary for the health and safety of the residents of the Town of Saratoga.

Section 2 Violations and Penalties

Any person violating any of the provisions of the ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject of forfeiture of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) or more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof, shall be imprisoned for a period of not less than one (1) day or not more than six (6) months or until such forfeiture and costs are paid.

Section 3 Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage upon the Town Board of the Town of Saratoga and upon publication provided by law.
